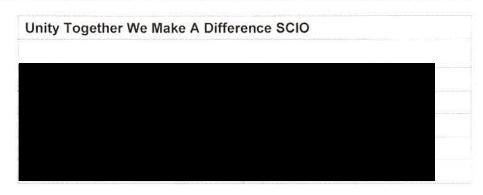

- 1. The prevention and relief of poverty by helping any suffering person to gain access to funds and grants or through the provision of financial assistance by ourselves.
- 2. The advancement of citizenship or community development by holding classes, events and seminars structured to increase engagement and to help empower communities to overcome social, economic and environmental challenges.
- 3. The provision of recreational facilities, or the organisation of recreational activities, with the object of improving the conditions of life for the persons for whom the facilities or activities are primarily intended by running various sports classes including but not limited to football, badminton, cricket, yoga and Zumba.
- 4. The relief of those in need by reason of age, ill-health, disability, financial hardship or other disadvantage by providing funds for the reconstruction of schools, places of worship and homes, by providing basic food provisions for the poor and those affected by natura disasters or war and the establishment of medical and rehabilitation clinics for victims of war, oppression and drug abuse.

### Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

The Charity has raised over £116k previously £66k for the period to 30<sup>th</sup> April 2024.

After costs the charity has donated over £83k previously £42k to recreational facilities, providing basic food provision for the poor and those affected by natural disasters and war.

The charity had donated to the other areas further a field and helping the less developed countries throughout the world and other local communities and local campaigns.

### Financial review

Brief statement of the charity's policy on reserves

The unrestricted funds represent income donated but not yet utilised in supporting charitable activities. At 30<sup>th</sup> April 2024 the charity held £26,021 previously £10,232 at the cash/bank. This will then accumulates in future years to respond to other charitable organisations.

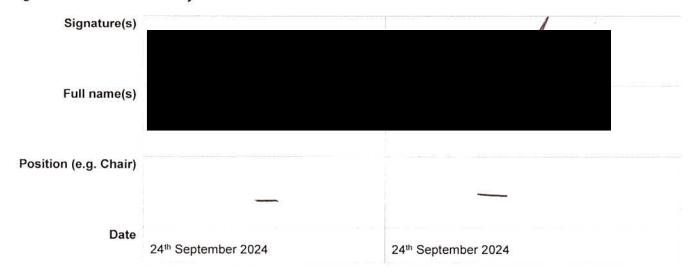

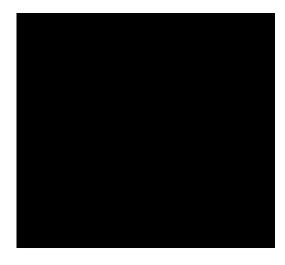
