with other local organisations, assisting each other and enjoying fun and friendship.

Summary of the main activities in relation to these objects

- Holding twice weekly meetings so that members can gather and talk over anything that may be affecting them or the local community. We also host sessions at our temporary workshop in North Queensferry.
- Carrying out team building projects within the local community.
- Creating arts and crafts for sale in local markets
- Train members on using tools to help them become more confident in working with wood.
- We also carry out training with new members on how to use the workshop equipment. We also gave instruction on woodworking to a number of special needs people which helped increase their personal selfconfidence.

Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

Our membership continues to grow, albeit slowly. We have been hindered in member growth as we are yet to move into a permanent site in Rosyth. We still await approval for our Planning Application on land identified by us and Fife Council. We currently have nearly 40 members and know that our membership will increase once we have a proper base in Rosyth

As our exploits are documented in Facebook we attract a lot of attention from organisations and residents looking for assistance.

Our efforts within the Workshop are proving to be very popular with our garden furniture making and bespoke pen turning being very well received.

We took part in the Christmas tree initiative in conjunction with the Rosyth Community Council.

Our members also helped the Rosyth Parish Church with their nativity scene installation.

Our fundraising efforts are focused raising money together to build a permanent home for this charity in Rosyth. This has been very productive with donations received from various sources

We partnered with St John's Primary Scholl to paint 2 classrooms while other funding was not available to the school.

Our members supplied assistance to the Rosyth Gala over 3 days. Jobs varied from stall building, dismantling and marshalling on the day to ensure smooth running and an enjoyable experience for visitors.

In accordance with the Constitution, Trustees hold office for three years after which they put themselves forward for re-election at the AGM.

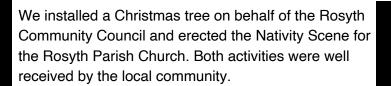
There must be a minimum of three and a maximum of four trustees.

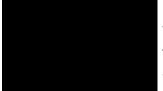
We have improved our skills on the tools at the workshop and have managed to add Laser Engraving to our portfolio.

We had a very interesting project at the beginning of 2024, assisting the NQ Community Trust convert the bow of an abandoned boat into a shelter for visitors to the pier.

Financial review

This is our second year as a fully incorporated charity.

We did receive a donation from the COVID Recovery Fund, however, this funding is restricted to the implementation of the permanent home for the Rosyth Mens Shed within Rosyth.

We now have a committee member who is a very focused Fund Raiser and has helped keep the roof over our heads with his efforts.

Statement of the charity's policy on reserves

We have nearly £40,000 that may be classed as reserves. However, this money is a restricted donation received from the COVID Recovery Fund and can only be used for the implementation of the permanent site in Rosyth

Our primary focus is acquiring land within Rosyth so that the Rosyth Men's Shed can have a permanent home.
