The minibus, although now twenty years old, is still providing excellent service and helps greatly in transporting our vulnerable group to and from regular club meetings and outings.

This year the Branch will again remain open during part of the month of June, a very popular decision with our members.

Trustees Remuneration and Expenses.

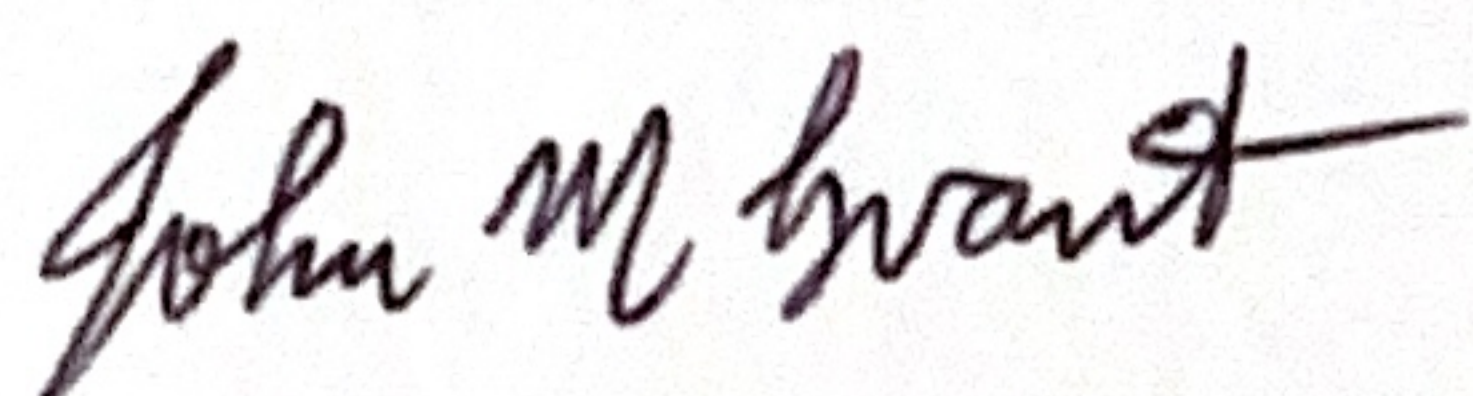
The trustees received no remuneration or expenses during this year.

Reserves.

At present the Committee holds unrestricted reserves of **£16,884.63**, a decrease of **£26.12** over the amount held at the same period in 2025. The decline in reserves of the recent years seems to have paused, hopefully stopped, mainly due to the greatly increased returns from our fundraising activities.

The Committee believes our present reserves should be sufficient to ensure the viability of the Branch for many years to come.
