Objectives and activities

Charitable purposes

The mission of the charity is to encourage citizens of all ages, communities and local organisations based in Glasgow and the surrounding area, to participate in sport and related physical activities through this to live a healthy lifestyle.

To provide a unified and independent voice for member sports clubs and organisations to improve sport experiences across Glasgow and assisting members to develop their clubs and organisations.

Summary of the main activities in relation to these objects

During the year we again ran our successful Achievement of the Month Awards and Annual Recognition Awards. The later awards were held in the Banqueting Hall of the City Chambers in Glasgow.

We were also voted Scottish Clubsport Network of the Year and finally achieved recognition by completing and being Award the Good Governance Award.

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Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

There were 12 monthly Achievement of the Month Awards during the membership year, and we had 19 Award Categories in the Annual Awards held in November at the City Chambers in Glasgow.

The membership subcommittee under the Chair of [REDACTED] also worked to help get members to renew their membership and recruit new clubs to join.

We ran a first aid course in conjunction with the SYFA West Region, and 20 members completed that training and achieved their certification.

We helped support Th Glasgow City Cup a youth International football tournament where 5,300 children took part at the Glasgow Green in August 2024.

Financial review

Brief statement of the charity's policy on reserves

We undertook a review of current costs and were able to reduce outgoings. Our reserves are sufficient for several years to come.

Details of any deficit

We incurred a deficit of £1,976 this was mainly due to the running costs of the Annual Awards. (Down from £3,752 the previous year)

Donated facilities and services (if any)

We have access to office facilities through Glasgow Life at the Emirates Arena

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Other optional information

In our 46th year of existence the Sports Council for Glasgow have had several excellent projects and achievements through 2024 / 2025.

We have been awarded the Good Governance Award, and this has been mainly the work of Trustees [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] who both spent many hours working on various modules for this Award.

We have reached and exceeded our target of 200 members. With further plans to recruit more member clubs during 2025, we hope to exceed numbers from last year with the introduction of a "Boost Your Club" small grant of up to £100 this will help grassroots member clubs throughout the year.

We are currently working on a new Strategy to hopefully take us towards 2028. We held an initial meeting in December 2024 with plans to "advance the public participation in Sport and Healthy Living in Glasgow." The use of [REDACTED] from CEIS as an outside agency, has helped us get a better focus on what strategic themes and goals matter for our members and how best to achieve them.

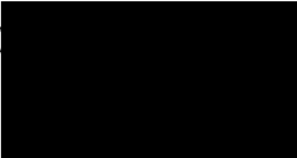
