Introduction

On behalf of the Trustees, I am pleased to present the Annual Report for the School for Social Entrepreneurs Scotland SCIO. The SCIO has continued to focus on establishing and maintaining strong governance arrangements and ensuring it remains well positioned to deliver charitable activity in line with its purposes when appropriate opportunities arise.

Charitable Purposes and Activities

The SCIO was established to advance education and promote the voluntary sector by supporting social enterprises and social businesses. It also would act, should the need arise, as a vehicle to receive Scottish funding opportunities. During this reporting period, the SCIO did not undertake externally facing charitable programmes or generate income. However, the Trustees have remained active in exploring opportunities, ensuring that the organisation is properly constituted, compliant with all legal and regulatory requirements, and prepared for future activity aligned with its charitable objectives.

Governance and Compliance

The Trustees have met to review governance matters, consider future opportunities, and confirm that statutory duties continue to be met. This includes maintaining accurate records, reviewing policies, and ensuring the organisation remains in good standing with OSCR. The SCIO continues to be managed in accordance with the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the SCIO Constitution.

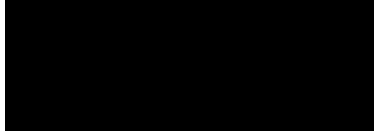
Financial Position

The current Trustees are:



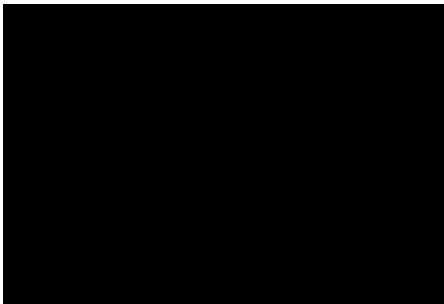
There were no changes to Trustees during the year.
