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Report of the Trustees for the Year Ended 31 December 2023

The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 December 2023. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019).

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

The network's main objective is to work together to promote better outcomes for people in receipt of Self-Directed Support (SDS) or who are interested in pursuing this means to enable independent living, improve quality of life, and facilitate active participation in and full integration into society.

ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE

Charitable activities

The Board meets every six weeks via Zoom.

We have kept a tight rein on expenditure and are fortunate that all our Board Members are volunteers and take no remuneration.

The Network continues to directly assist people who are in dispute on various issues with South Lanarkshire Council about SDS budgets and process. This year the main issues have come following an annual review of individual & carers SDS budgets which has highlighted the problem of the correct documentation not being in place leading to confusion and misunderstandings on what budgets were to be spent on.

We submitted three Freedom of Information (FOI) requests this year, two to South Lanarkshire Council and one to the Scottish Government.

The requests to the council were to get details of the number of people receiving SDS and to get clarity on process documentation that needs to be in place when a financial review is taking place

The FOI to the Scottish Government was to understand their policy position on charging.

Details of the FOI's are on our website.

Unfortunately, we were unable to get an administrator to deal with our day-to-day workload. Despite placing an advert with VASLAN only one person declared an interest.

We continue to operate with a small number of Board Members, we would encourage members to join or Board Meetings which are on Zoom and consider joining the Board.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Financial position

The Statement of Financial Activities shows net loss for the period of £2,412 2022 £1,659 and our reserves stand at £11,972 2022 £14,384.

Governing document

The Network was set up by group of S. Lanarkshire residents in January 2011 and was recognised as a Scottish Charity with effect from 12 Sept 2012. The Network changed its Legal form to a SCIO on 28th August 2014. The Network is administered in accordance with the terms of its Constitution.

Recruitment and appointment of new trustees

The trustees of the Network are the four Office Bearers (Chairman, vice-chairman, secretary and treasurer) and the members of the Management Committee. Appointment and removal is in accordance with the Constitution which requires that trustees are elected/removed by the membership in General meeting

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charity, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Charities Act 2011. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Computer equipment - 15% on reducing balance

Taxation

The charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.
