The activities experienced by the children included, pony and trap rides, giant footballs, pet goats, petting ponies, petting sheepvarious bouncy castles and crossing a rope bridge supported by 46th Aberdeen Scout Group, Enjoying games at the funfair stalls. This year there were also new events for the children to have fun with and these included the Critter Keeper, climbing tower, bungee trampoline, musical puppets, the Ambulance Service, Mountain Rescue Support and Rescue Assistance
