**Notes to the accounts for the year to 31 August 2025**

1. Basis of accounting.

These accounts have been prepared on the Receipts and Payments basis in accordance with the Charities & Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006 (as amended)

2. Restricted funds. There are no restricted funds

3. No remuneration, fees or expenses were paid to the Trustees.

4. Governance costs. There were no material Governance costs.

5. There were no donations received in this year.

6. There were no Turkish Classes have been held since Dec'18 due to lack of teachers and alter due to Covid-19 pandemic. The charity did not carry out any activities during 2024-2025 financial period.

7. In promoting Turkish arts and culture in Edinburgh, which is one of Speak Turkish's core aims, Speak Turkish decided to donate their funds in small amounts a multiple of ~£500 to Turkish origin/heritage performers at the Edinburgh Fringe.

8. There is £450 deficit during 2024-2025 financial period occurred due to Speak Turkish paid £450.00 to cover one of the show's expenses (See note 7).

**Independent Examiner's Report**

I report on the financial statements of the charity Speak Turkish for the year ended 31 August 2024, which are set out on page 1 above.

**Respective responsibilities of Trustees and Examiner**

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 ("the 2005 Act") and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006 (as amended) ("the 2006 Regulations"). The charity's trustees consider that the audit requirement of Regulation 10(1)(d) of the 2006 Regulations does not apply. It is my responsibility to examine the accounts as required under section (44)(1)(c) of the 2005 Act and to state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

**Basis of Independent Examiner's Statement**

My examination is carried out in accordance with Regulation 11 of the 2006 Regulations. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts and seeks explanations from the trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit and, consequently, I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.

**Independent Examiner's Statement**
