Statement of Trustees – June 2026

A long-awaited bequest, which has been the subject of an investigation by HMRC into taxation of the testator, is still awaiting a final decision although we understand that HMRC are now in a position to move that forward.

Projects

As in previous years, at nil cost, we have been able to get volunteer support to work on the translation of existing projects. This has included working on *Bluesky* (the free competitor for Twitter/"X")

1. We've continued maintenance of existing projects such as **Mozilla**, **LibreOffice** and **Scratch** through volunteer effort.
2. Face to face work remains on hold.

Funding

Work is continuing on developing direct donations via the web platform. Small individual donations continue to accrue but no expenditure is being incurred.

We are now in discussions with a third party about how to improve fundraising.

Expenses

When the charity was originally set up there were costs totalling £2,304.73 which have been the subject of an interest-free loan. That is gradually being repaid, the first such payment of £500 being on 18 May 2024. In previous years the end-of-year bank balance was always higher than at outset. For the year ended in January 2026 that is not the case as an additional £800 of the loan balance has been repaid in two tranches:

Outlook

This continues to be uncertain due to lack of funds to engage in other activities, however the Trustees remain committed to keeping things moving forward, however slowly. The charity will not engage in expenditure without having in place the funds required.

Accounts

For the period from 26 January 2025 to 25 January 2026 the charity has had no transactions other than the small receipts noted above and has effectively remained financially dormant.
