Structure, governance and management

Type of governing document

The Scotland Synod is a constituent part of the Methodist Church of Great Britain and as such is constituted and regulated by the Constitutional Practice and Discipline of the Methodist Church. The Synod of The Methodist Church in Scotland is a body which has oversight of six areas (Circuits) across Scotland and meets twice a year to receive reports.

Trustee recruitment and appointment

The trustees are the members of the District Policy Committee (excluding and are appointed by District Synod.

Members of Synod are all the Methodist ministers, deacons and probationer ministers in Scotland, lay officers, one circuit steward from each of the six circuits in Scotland, lay members elected by their circuit to attend, all members of the District Policy Committee and all lay representatives elected by the Synod to the last preceding or next following Conference.

Objectives and activities

Charitable purposes

The purpose of Synod is the advancement of the Christian religion, particularly within the Methodist Church of Great Britain, and the oversight of all Methodist churches in Scotland. These churches are grouped into six areas (Circuits) who report annually to the Synod, and twice yearly to the District Policy Committee. The Synod finances here reported are those required to run a virtual office, and the administration of the lead minister, (District Chair), who is remunerated by The Methodist Church of Great Britain. The individual Circuits and Churches each have their own finances and are registered individually with OSCR.

Summary of the main activities in relation to these objects

The Synod comprises 28 churches throughout Scotland with 14 ministers and deacons, 1 circuit lay workers and 2 lay voluntary pastoral assistants encompassed within six Circuits.

Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

Synod meets twice a year in September and April.
September is the business meeting when reports from the national
Methodist Conference are heard and any decisions which have been
taken there are explained to members in detail.

As our end of year is 31st August the April meeting is when members can be brought up to date on all activities being undertaken under the Methodist District of Scotland. This takes the form of a Synod Reports booklet prepared prior to this meeting in order that members can be prepared should they wish to challenge any action. The index of this booklet conveys the breadth of activities and accomplishments many of which only receive proper attention at Synod as people are unaware of matters which they do not experience first hand.

The year to 31st August 2024continues to see rationalisation of resources and activities and looking to the future. Since the Coronavirus pandemic, more meetings have been held over the internet, reducing travel costs, but with some increases in expenditure.

During the year the District Project in Inverness came to the end of its funding from the District, and there is a national review about the funding of the Safeguarding Officer.

Financial review

Brief statement of the charity's policy on reserves

Synod would aim to have reserves in the General Fund of approximately three months expenditure, circa £30,000 in unrestricted funds, and in the Advance Fund of three years grants, circa £120,000 available at the year end.

For this year 2023/24, we continued examining our income and expenditure very closely and were satisfied to be carrying forward a balance of £435,439 to year 2024/25.


