I became chair at the beginning of January 2026 when an essentially all new board of trustees was formed to ensure that Age Concern Girvan could continue to support the community.

We agreed to suspend the Monday and Friday three-course meal services until April 2026 – the beginning of the next financial year – to give us time to assess the current financial position of the charity, make sure the kitchen was fit for purpose and ensure we had enough volunteers. Through this period, we are indebted to Girvan Opportunities who kept the kitchen service running on Mondays and Fridays by providing both staff, and a soup and sandwiches service. This was at no cost to the charity and free to customers, many of whom made generous donations.

We also agreed to employ a paid cook for the new financial year, and I am pleased to report that this has been very successful. A grant for the cook's wages for one year has also been secured.

Also, in the first few months of the year, we held a bingo night which was well attended and generated useful funds.

Together with other donations and support, all of which is gratefully received, we are now in a healthy position to continue the work of this worthwhile charity.

Finally, I would like to give a massive thank you to all the trustees who have worked hard to make all of this possible.
