Halkirk Heritage & Vintage Motor Society, formed in 2006, owns the properties formerly The Old School, Sinclair Street, Halkirk, and store at Old Smiddy, Bridge Street, Halkirk, formerly known as Bond Electrical. As both properties are old buildings there is a continued programme of repair and maintenance to keep them both wind and watertight which is normally carried out in the closed season – unless urgency dictates otherwise. It changed its status to a SCIO in August 2024

Once renovated and extension erected the Old School opened in 2022 as the Halkirk Heritage & Vintage Motor Centre. The Centre is open from Easter and closes at the end of October each year. Visitors can enjoy a range of vintage and classic vehicles on display, learn about the local heritage of the area; one area is used to host a different exhibition annually. There is an extensive reading room which hosts old local newspapers, family history information, local and national history, photographs etc. Group visits are especially welcome and are arranged at a day and time to suit each specific group. Ad hoc private visits outside normal opening hours are also accommodated. A small selection of local postcards, and our logo branded items are offered for sale along with surplus books and artifacts. Around 1500 visitors in 2025, admission is free but donations are welcome
