### Achievements and performance

#### Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

During our 2<sup>nd</sup> year of operating, our volunteer drivers provided transport for 62 clients to attend 692 appointments. These journeys were to 12 different medical centres, predominately the Glasgow Beatson, and covered 30,894 miles and in December we completed our 1,000<sup>th</sup> client journey.

In July we extended our coverage to the communities of Carron and Carronshore.

The client feedback received this year continues to be humbling, and supports our aim that we are removing some worry about how clients would otherwise attend their medical appointments.

As a new charity demand for our service is continuing to grow as the community become aware of our existence. However, we aim to build and maintain sufficient funds to cover estimated operational costs for 2 years. We will do this by engaging with the community and fundraising.


