

We are a youth and community charity organisation based in the Dryburgh area of Dundee, with the promise of leisure, learning and local action for all ages.

We work tirelessly to improve the physical, mental, and emotional health of our young people and local adults who reside in the Dryburgh, Lochee and Charleston areas which rank as some of Dundee's most deprived areas.
