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Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

During the year we had a total membership of 134 swimmers being taught each week over the three hour period we use the pool.

In addition to the weekly lessons we have also held fun nights, splash galas and the Championship Gala.

We have new assistant teachers being trained at the poolside and we were successful in being awarded a substantial payment from the Helter Skelter Fund and we plan to use this money towards running a teaching course towards the end of next year.

We have a policy of retaining a minimum reserves value of around £3,000 which is represented by cash held in our current account. This allows any small surplus or deficit each year to be comfortably supported by historic reserves.
