Objectives and activities

The aims of the charity St. Andrew's Kirk, Glass are:

To permanently preserve the building known as Glass Parish Church as a church accessible by the public.

To advance arts, heritage, culture, or science by making the building accessible to the public for such use.

To advance community development.

The programme of repairs and refurbishment continued through the year with repairs to the main doors and then painting.

Settlement and damage to the 2 remaining plain glass windows on the West face was noted and an estimate for refurbishment obtained. This work will be carried out as funds permit.

An evening concert was provided by the Aurora Choir from Huntly with refreshments kindly supplied by local volunteers. This was very successful, and the new facilities were well used.

Glass Primary School held a Christmas Concert and raised a collection for the church.

One wedding and one funeral of local people were held in the church.

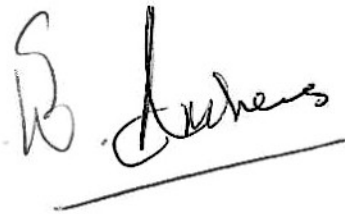
