## Structure, governance and management

Type of governing document

The Charity is a Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organisation (a SCIO). It was formed and registered in its current legal form on 7th November 2023. It has a single tier structure and as such the trustees are the members of the charity

Trustee recruitment and appointment

The affairs of the club are conducted by the management committee, which can meet every 3 months and is open to adult members of the Club. The Trustees and management committee are elected at the annual general meeting which is normally held in December. There must be a minimum of three trustees.

## Objectives and activities

Charitable purposes

Advance the public participation in Aquatic Sports in accordance with paragraph C2.1 of the SASA Constitution.

## Summary of the main activities in relation to these objects

The charity is set up to advance the public participation in Aquatics sports, predominately through the coaching of water polo in the Strathclyde area.

These objectives are met through:

Weekly coaching sessions in the Oneren area for youth and inclusive (for children with additional support needs) water polo programmes.

Coaching of water polo for children with additional support needs in the East Dunbartonshire area.

Running of an annual water polo camp.

Purchase of water polo equipment for use at all sessions.

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### Achievements and performance

#### Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

Coaching of the Oneren youth and inclusive water polo programmes which currently have over 40 children active and over 60 children on the waiting list. The cost to the children is £1 per week paid directly to the swimming pool by the parents of the children to cover the cost of pool hire. The inclusive water polo programme is for children with additional support needs

Coaching of water polo for children with additional support needs continued in Kirkintilloch. which we were able to provide for free.

Strathclyde Aquatics coaches provide the only specific coaching for children with additional support needs in the UK, with 10 children taking part in weekly sessions.

The charity held their annual water polo camp this time with Olympic, World and European Champion Anni Espar from Spain. Over 30 children from across Scotland took part in a memorable day of water polo.
