Objectives and activities

Structure, governance and management

Type of governing document

The Charity is a Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organisation (a SCIO). It was registered in its current legal form on 30th November 2021. The charity was previously an unincorporated association but changed its legal form to a SCIO. It has a single tier structure and as such the trustees are the members of the charity.

Trustee recruitment and appointment

The management committee, which normally meets each month, is formed of the charity's trustees and other volunteers. Membership of the management committee is open to interested members of the community.

Trustees are elected at the annual general meeting which is held in October. There must be a minimum of three and a maximum of five trustees.

Achievements and performance

The charity holds in-person and online events focused on the Islamic calendar.
