Trust & Trustees:

The Titwood Sports Ground Trust is based at the Titwood Sports Ground, 22 Beaton Road, Glasgow G41 4LA. For administrative purposes, correspondence is addressed through the Chairman, Frank Hirst "Gryffe View" Mill of Gryffe Road, Bridge of Weir, Renfrewshire PA11 3LZ.

The Trust is governed by nine Trustees, Frank Hirst, Alan Sloan, Murray Macara, Craig Madden, John Henderson, Alastair Robertson, Greig Williamson, Rennie Keith and Colin Mitchell. New Trustees are appointed by unanimous vote of the existing Trustees. Trustees are drawn from, in the main, past presidents and experienced members from the cricket and hockey clubs who are the tenants of the grounds. Trustees operate in a voluntary capacity and no expenses are paid.

The Trust operates under a Deed of Amendment, ref 10/37236 of an Extract Registered on 30 September 2010 in the Books of Council and Session.

Purposes:

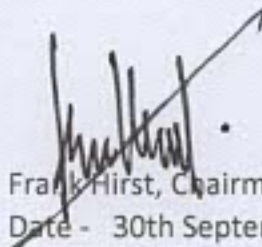
The Purposes of the Trust are: a) to improve the health, welfare, and quality of life of those living in Glasgow and the surrounding area, b) to encourage, promote and develop public participation in sport, particularly in cricket and hockey, c) to foster citizenship and sustain and enhance the local community by participation in sport, d) to achieve the foregoing purposes by maintaining, improving and where deemed appropriate replacing the Sports Ground, including the pitches, clubhouses and pavilions thereon, so as to provide quality facilities for sport, particularly cricket and hockey and if considered appropriate other forms of physical recreation, e) in the event that the foregoing Purposes shall in our reasonable opinion become incapable of fulfilment at any time to hold the Sports Ground and other property, if any, then comprising the Trust Estate and the proceeds of sale thereof firstly, for the provision of alternative facilities suitable for use by those members of the public who require Sports Ground facilities and secondly for the promotion, encouragement, development and participation of the general public in Glasgow and the surrounding area in the sports of hockey and cricket or such other sports as we may reasonably determine.

Activities:

The sports ground is an international standard facility for both hockey and cricket. The hockey pitch and MUGA were used for international coaching, training and matches at youth and senior level. The cricket and hockey pitches continued to be used to host National, Regional and District League and Cup matches involving the tenant club, and external users, and for international matches. The MUGA and pitch facilities are used on a daily basis by, local schools and for hockey and cricket training by the tenant club. The ground, MUGA and clubhouse facilities used on a regular basis by clubs affiliated to the tenant club which is a "Community Sports Hub".

Finance:

The income of the Trust in the last financial year has been the annual rent from the tenant club. The Capital amount of £29,000 shown in the accounts is the value of the sports ground at cost. Further details are shown in the statement of accounts.
