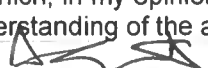

We were invited to play at various events during the year 2025-26. We made donations to 3 local charities in December. Members propose local charities and the whole group vote for the ones they would like to make donations to.

We held our annual Rally in May 2025 which was a great success with the venue at full capacity. Planning for our Fiddlers Rally in May 2026 is underway.

We held successful fiddle workshops in November and have new members following this.
